### **Catering**

Having located St Mary's Church **HU17 8DL**, drive along Hengate and turn right at the lights (Note "The White Horse Inn" – "Nellies" on the right as you approach the lights). Carry on past TESCO and look out for the Fire Station on your left. Turn left immediately along School Lane and you will see the car park straight ahead. The Long Stay area is clearly marked on the ground.

Note - Driving around Beverley – The centre of Beverley is pedestrianised, and many streets are one-way.

### **Public Transport**

There is a train station in Beverley. However, the main inter-change is Kingston upon Hull, where main line services terminate, requiring changes to Beverley. **Hull Trains** run regular services to and from London Kings Cross to Hull Paragon. If using the train services, it may be prudent to travel on Friday / Sunday with overnight accommodation in Beverley.
