Toilets, including an accessible WC, are available next to the Parish Centre in the Lower ground Floor. There is lift access if required. There are two steps between the Church and the Parish Centre, but there is level access to the Parish Centre from the forecourt.

The church is fully wheelchair accessible with ramps. There is a step from the main entrance but there will be signs put up on the day to assist people and a door will be available to assist with step free access to the lift.

All assistance dogs are welcome.

## **Car parking and transport information**

### **Car parking**

There will be no car parking available directly outside the church. Car parking is available at the following:

- Princes Dock (L3 1DL)
- NCP car parks in Rumford Street (L2 8SZ)
- Fazakerley Street (L3 9DL)

There is also on street metered parking available in the streets around the church.

### **Public transport**

Liverpool Lime Street is the closest main line station. It is about 20 minute walk to the Church.

There are Merseyrail stations at James Street and Moorfields which link to Wirral Line and Northern Lines.

The main Bus station is located near the Albert Dock at Liverpool One which is approx. a 10 minute walk from the church. There is also a bus station at Queens Square which is approx. a 16 minute walk from the church.

Please plan your journeys well in advance in case of any football matches which can cause significant delays in journey times.
