Toilets

The church has two internal toilets & two outside the entrance before going up the tower.

There is also a public toilet block in All Saints square below the church. It is pay per visit!

Travel & Accommodation

There is a recently opened Travelodge S60 1QJ, within 5 mins walk of both church and station

From Sheffield, Meadowhall & Doncaster (There is no direct main line train service)

Local train to Rotherham Central or by Tram/train from Tinsley South on the tram network

Local bus service from Sheffield & Doncaster

By car:- Free parking in off street car parks at Drummond Street S65 1HP in both red and white zone spaces; Douglas Street. S60 2DL (2hrs max); Clifton Hall. S65 1ER; Riverside, S60 1QA; Wellgate Multi Storey S60 2LT; Broom Valley road offers free on street parking away from the yellow lines.

Obviously all this depends on finding available spaces. All on street parking is pay at a meter £4.20 for up to 4 hrs

Things to do

For the non-ringer, options available include a new cinema on Forge Island offering a range of films in the afternoon.
